## WHO ARE “WE”

- We are the Canadian Transportation Museum & Heritage Village located in Essex Ontario.
- We were founded in the early 1950's and have become a hands-on learning centre for children of all ages right up to and including retirement home residents, and of course, the general public.
- We are situated on a 100 acre site, with a 25,000 sq. ft. modern transportation museum and a village housing over 20 period buildings, fully furnished, from the 1800's to the early 1900's.
- We are a registered charity and as such, can issue tax receipts for accepted donations.
- We are LCBO licensed and operate a full-time 1950's diner, a summer village kitchen, along with a modern gift shop.
- We provide guided tours of our extensive collection including:
  - antique vehicles
  - early flight
  - railroad
  - firefighting and veterans recognition displays
  - period garages
  - gas station equipment
  - introduction to Edwardian education

-As well as nostalgia related to early rock 'n roll, racing, drive-in movies, restaurants and road houses (CKLW Radio 80, Checker Flag Raceway, Skyway drive-in, Hi-Ho, Elmwood Casino)

- We are a first class and very busy venue for weddings in our circa 1885 non-denominational village church and modern reception hall.
- We also produce over 20 annual fund-raising shows and events open to the general public.
- We host over 10,000 students and teachers annually for day programs. To date we have had over 250,000 students participate in our various education programs.
- We receive over 40,000 visitors annually, and over the years have had in excess of 1,000,000 visitors pass through our doors
- We employ 5 full-time and several part-time employees year round, and many summer students.
